
Abalone

Most common are the greenlip and blacklip. Abalone are distinguished by a large ear-shaped shell with a series of respiratory holes. No operculum.


Black shell, white apex and white margin around aperture. Occurs in high abundances in upper intertidal zone, usually clustered under boulders.

Crab — Ozius truncatus





Measure a crab across the widest part of the carapace. This crab grows up to 100 mm across the carapace.

Solid, slow-moving crab.
Occurs commonly under rocks at lower tidal levels.
Dark grey-brown carapace with margin that is relatively straight between the eyes.
Large, black-tipped claws often uneven in size.
