

Dicathais orbita



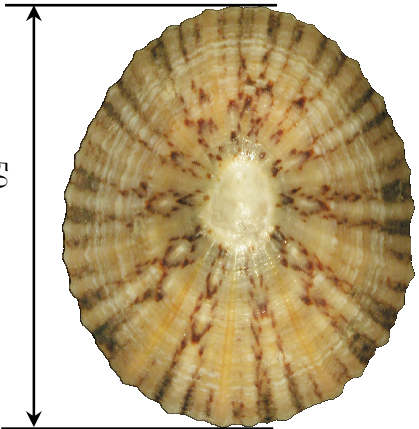
Important predator on rocky shores. Large, solid, oval-shaped shell. Shell is cream to white and can be completely covered by algae. Animal is usually dark red colour. It occurs singly, or in small groups, in crevices and rock pools at mid-low tide levels and below, often in regions of very strong wave action.

Warrener/Periwinkle *Turbo undulatus*



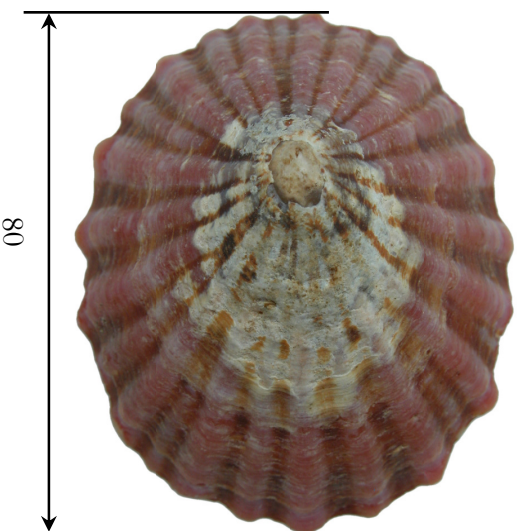
Smooth, round and turban-shaped shell with mottled green markings. Algal feeder. Found at mid-low tide levels in rock pools and crevices on medium to high energy coasts. White shelly operculum.

Limpets



Cellana tramoserica

Orange-brown limpet with dark radiating stripes or crescent-shaped markings. Colour is variable. Occurs across a broad range of tide levels from the high water mark down. It is more common at the mid tide levels.



Cellana solida

Much larger than *C. tramoserica*, with fewer radiating ribs. Occupies same habitat as *C. tramoserica*. Very often occurs with very eroded apex.
